# A BILL

To amend title 31, United States Code, to terminate the  
Presidential \$1 Coin Program, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Wasteful Presidential  
5 Coin Act of 2011”.

6 **SEC. 2. TERMINATION OF THE PRESIDENTIAL \$1 COIN PRO-**  
7 **GRAM..**

8 (a) IN GENERAL.—Section 5112 of title 31, United  
9 States Code, is amended by striking subsection (n).

1 (b) EFFECTIVE DATE.—The amendment made by  
2 subsection (a) shall take effect at the end of the 30-day  
3 period beginning on the date of the enactment of this Act.

4 **SEC. 3. RESTRICTION ON OVERPRODUCTION OF \$1 COINS.**

5 Section 5112 of title 31, United States Code, is  
6 amended by adding at the end the following new sub-  
7 section:

8 “(w) RESTRICTION ON OVERPRODUCTION OF \$1  
9 COINS.—Notwithstanding any other provision of this sec-  
10 tion, no \$1 coin may be minted or issued under this sec-  
11 tion during any period in which the number of \$1 coins  
12 issued, but not in circulation, is more than 10 percent of  
13 the number of \$1 coins in circulation.”.
